Dr Anne-Marie Imafidon MBE is a prodigy in every sense of the word. Aged 11, she was the youngest girl ever to pass A-level Computing, and was just 20 years old when she received her Master's Degree in Mathematics and Computer Science from the University of Oxford. Since then, she has forged an enviable CV, including positions at blue-chip companies. Then there are the Honorary Doctorates from Open University, Glasgow Caledonian University, Kent University & Bristol University as well as an Honorary Fellowship at Keble College, Oxford & Visiting Professorship at Sunderland University.

It is this wealth of experience and pioneering spirit that led her to co-found the Stemettes, an award-winning social initiative dedicated to inspiring and promoting the next generation of young women in the STEM sectors. Since its inception 7 years ago, it has exposed almost 45,000 girls across Europe to Anne-Marie's vision for a more diverse and balanced science and tech community.

A respected thought-leader in the tech space and trustee at the Institute for the Future of Work, Anne-Marie was awarded an MBE in 2017. In addition to hosting the hugely popular Women Tech Charge Podcast for the Evening Standard, she regularly appears in international media and is a sought-after keynote speaker, presenter and conference facilitator, having conducted live interviews with famous faces from the tech world and beyond, including Jack Dorsey, Rachel Riley and Lewis Hamilton.
